Swansea to Host IMLAM 2023

From 2006 to 2022 Australia's Murdoch University of Perth ran the annual International Maritime Law Arbitration Moot (IMLAM) for law students worldwide.

The Moot has been exceptionally-well supported over many years by the maritime industry and shipping law firms, and by members of MLAANZ in particular. In recent years, the venue for the oral competition has changed every year, rotating between Australia, South East Asia and Europe.

The 2023 edition of IMLAM will be hosted by the Hillary Rodham Clinton School of Law, Swansea University, in the United Kingdom between July 1-6, in partnership with the law firm Holman, Fenwick, Willan.

The Swansea team have taken on the prime responsibility for managing the 2023 event.

This annual event is being hosted in person for the first time since the peak of the COVID-19 pandemic. The 2022 event was run virtually.

IMLAM brings together teams from around the world who showcase their legal knowledge and advocacy skills in strong competition. It is a competition open to any student enrolled in a law degree, either undergraduate or postgraduate, who has not been admitted to practice.
